1. What is the Mumbai University Admission Procedure?

Step 1: Student registers and logs on the website of University of Mumbai

Step 2: Student fills in his/her profile.

Step 3: Fill out the application form and upload all the necessary documents. Then submits his/her application at university of Mumbai Link.

2. What is the admission procedure of WCCBM?

Step 1: Fill university form and upload documents and select Western College of Commerce and Business Management, college code 530 as your priority college.

Step 2: Register yourself @ WCCBM and Fill WCCBM form at <https://wccbmd.linways.com/v4/adm-applicant/login>

Step 3: Visit the college Admission counseling team Ground Floor Room No 2

7. Is NEP applicable to us?

Yes, all students taking admission during 2024-25 will be under NEP system.

8. What is Major Subject?

A core subject in which a student is planning to graduate will be a major subject.

9. What is a Minor Subject?

As per NEP 2020, a student can have an interdisciplinary minor course. For example, a student pursuing a major bachelor's degree in Accounting and Finance can do a Minor in Data Science.

10. Is Hostel accommodation available for students?

Yes. Hostel accommodation is on a first come first serve basis and will be charged separately as per Vishweshwar society's norms.

11. How is grading done?

The University follows a semester system pattern-Choice Based Credit System which is globally accepted. The students have to earn credits over the span of Programmes which are disclosed in the Final Marksheet as their Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA) as well as Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA).

12. What is the difference between honors and degree?

An Honours degree typically refers to a higher level of academic achievement at an Undergraduate level. Bachelor - Honours will be awarded on completion of 4 academic years while a general bachelor's degree will be awarded on completion of 3 academic years.

13. What is attendance requirement?

The attendance requirement is, as per UGC guidelines, a minimum of 75% required in the academic term.

14. What is the mode of payment?

Online payment only. Any difficulty finance officer or Administration staff will help. Visit campus.

15. Can a student with GAP be admitted to the UG programmes of your college?

Yes. They will be treated as regular students if they fulfill admission criteria and should possess the required documents or certificates for the same.
